Luscious Lillies!

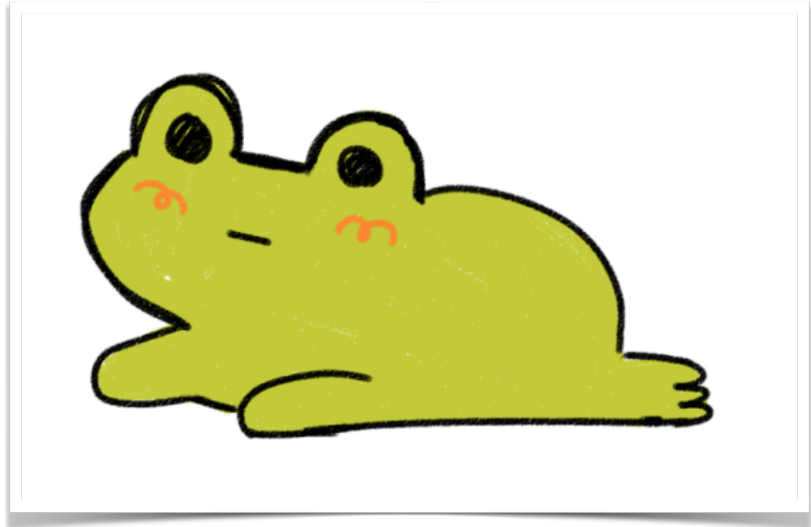

New Arrivals...

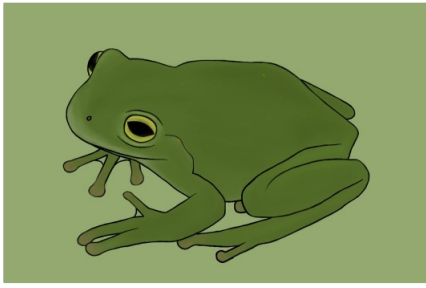
Frog news reporter Willy Hoppers reported "fur-like" creatures along the frog border. The Frog military declined to comment on the matter.
